# Lead Hazard Reduction Program

If eligible, can assist with eliminating lead-based paint hazards in your home for free.

## WHO?

- Households with a child under the age of 6 and/or a pregnant woman
- Properties that are located in the following zip codes: **48202 • 48204 • 48206 • 48209 • 48213 • / 48214**
- Low-income households (\$64,000 for a family of 4) AND/OR be enrolled in Medicaid
- Landlords with tenants meeting the above qualifications

## WHY?

- Lead is a toxic metal that may cause a range of health problems, especially in young children.
- Lead may cause behavioral problems, learning disabilities, seizures and in extreme cases, death.
- Children who are lead poisoned may show no symptoms.
- Homes built before 1978 likely contain lead-based paint.
